## Workshop Sessions

### **Workshop A: Sustainable Funding (For Staff)**

Graham Reekie from Wren and Greyhound will lead this session which will provide straightforward definitions and practical tools to help you assess, plan for and improve your sustainability

The workshop is based on the sustainability toolkit 'A Lasting Difference', exploring the four core capabilities of sustainability

- Involvement
- Income Generation
- Innovation and Improvement
- Impact Measurement.

### **Workshop B: Emergency Planning (For Carers)**

Provision for emergency and future planning now features in the **Carers (Scotland) Act 2016**, an important change which ENABLE Scotland campaigned for.

ENABLE has developed emergency planning resources which aim to support the implementation of these important provisions. The workshop aims to:

- Support the carer to identify informal networks of support who can step into their caring role when they are unavailable.
- Help support the carer share their experience of caring for their loved one.
- Discuss the caring responsibilities and identify who can help and for how long
- Ensure that emergency contacts know what is expected of them and that the plan is shared

### **Workshop C: Emergency Planning (For Staff)**

This workshop aims to:

- Increase awareness of emergency planning and its benefits for Carers.
- Provide skills which support emergency planning with carers.
- Look at provisions for Carers (Scotland) Act 2016 - emergency planning.
- Introduce future planning.
